

## SECONDS

If two words have virtually identical meanings, I sometimes use the same id with a circle around it for the less used word, calling it a "second."

Y Big	Y large	jump	leap
! Little	! small	idea	concept
Use	utilize	teach	instruct
Tear	rip	clothes	apparel
Dinner	supper	naked	nude

But just because a circle is used does not necessarily mean it's a second:

## LATIN, GREEK, AND OTHER LANGUAGE DOTS

A dot low on the left means Latin: permit medicinal subcutaneous  
 .per through, .mit send, .medere heal, .sub under, .cut skin

A dot high on the left means Greek: monopoly psychiatric hypodermic  
 'mono one, 'pol sell, 'psyche spirit, 'iatr heal, 'hypo under, 'derm skin
